## A232 Ewell Road – resurfacing works planned from 10 October 2016

I am writing to let you know that we are planning to carry out resurfacing works on the A232 Ewell Road, between the junctions of Roberts Close and Station Way, from 10 October.

As well as providing a smoother and safer surface for all road users, completing this work will also help avoid further major maintenance becoming necessary in the near future on this section of the road.

As the resurfacing cannot be completed while the carriageway is being used, a series of short-term temporary closures will be needed. You will find more details below.

### Temporary overnight closures of the A232 Ewell Road from 10 October

The works are planned on Monday to Thursday nights between 10 and 21 October. A series of temporary traffic management changes will apply while the works are completed:

12 October and 19 October	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The A232 Ewell Road will be closed to westbound traffic between Park Lane and Station Way. Ewell Road will be open to eastbound traffic as normal</li> <li>A diversion route for westbound traffic will be clearly signed via the A24 and the A2043</li> </ul>	21:00 each night until 05:00 the following morning
13 October and 20 October	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The A232 Ewell Road will be closed to eastbound traffic, between Park Lane and Station Way. Ewell Road will be open to westbound traffic as normal</li> <li>A diversion route for eastbound traffic will be clearly signed via the A24 and the A2043</li> </ul>	21:00 each night until 05:00 the following morning

Local access for residents from the A232 Ewell Road to The Avenue and other adjoining roads will be maintained and managed by traffic marshals. Access will also be maintained for emergency services at all times.

Please note that while every effort will be made to complete the resurfacing as planned, poor weather conditions may mean that the works need to be rescheduled at short notice. ### **Bus passengers**

### **Cyclists**

The dedicated cycle lanes will be temporarily suspended during the works. Cyclists should follow the signed diversion route.

### **Pedestrians**

Footways and pedestrian crossings will remain open, wherever possible, although some temporary closures may apply. Any closures will be clearly signed. Pedestrian access to properties will not be affected.

## **Working hours**

The working hours outlined above have been agreed with the London Borough of Sutton.
